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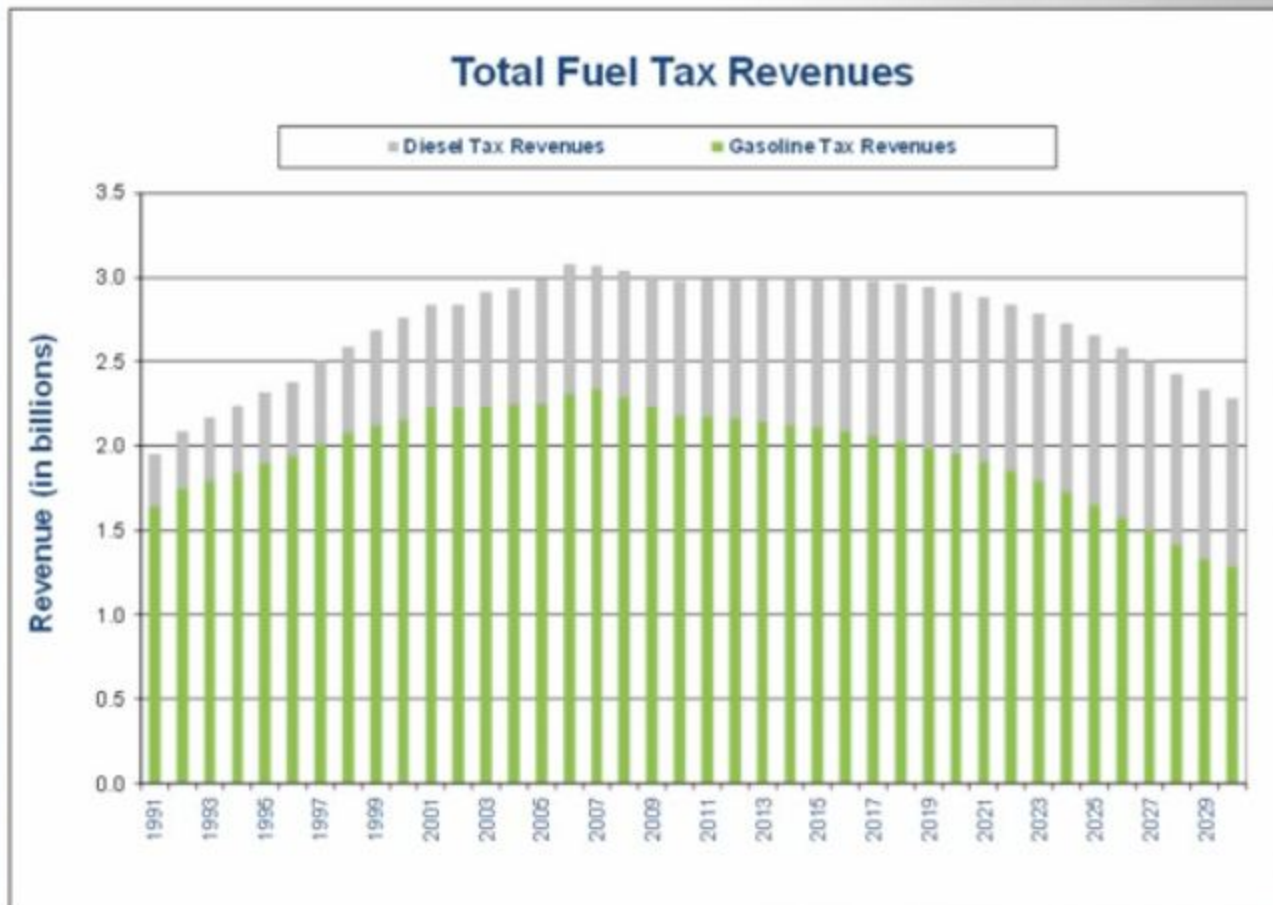

- National Surface Transportation Infrastructure Financing Commission (2009)



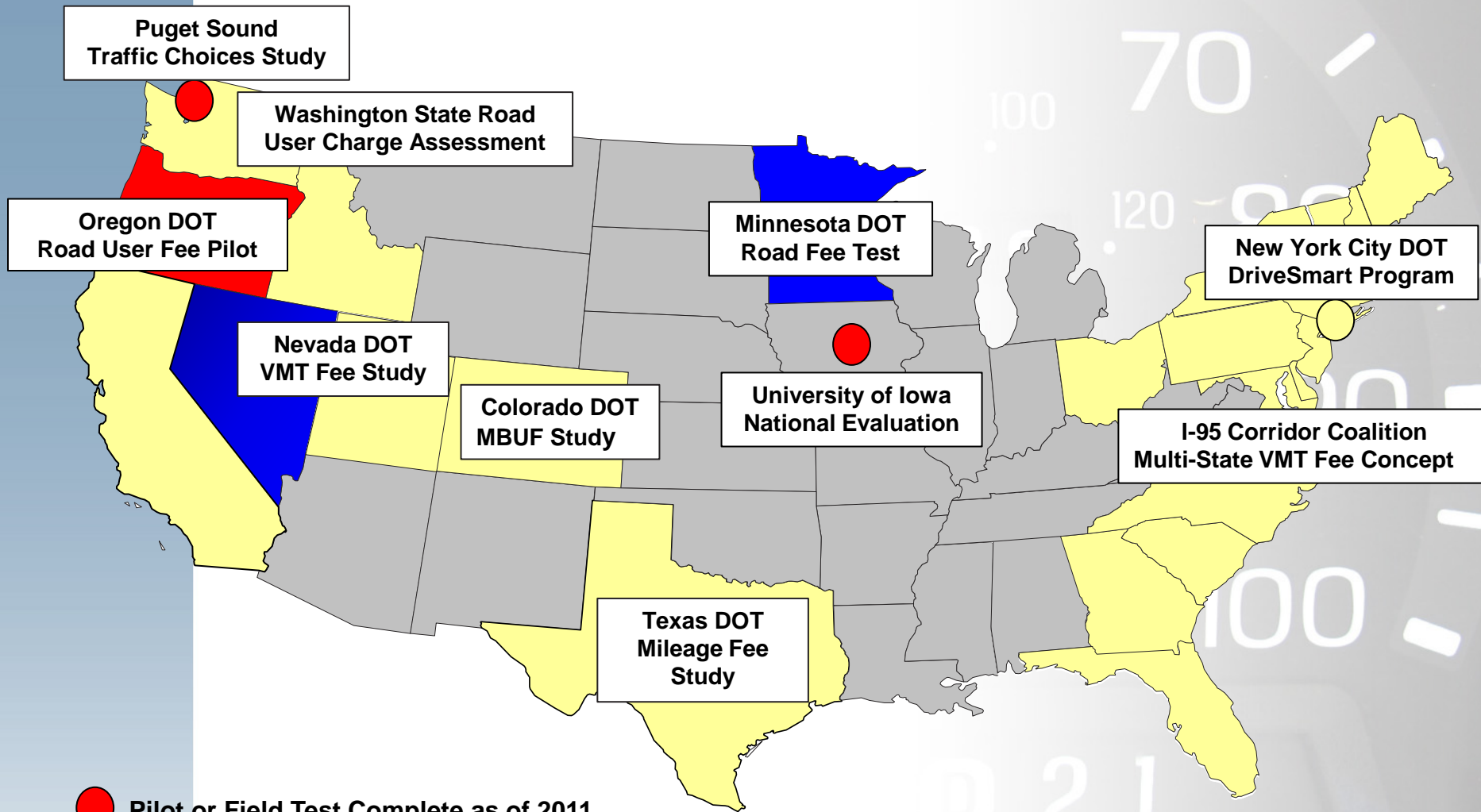
Annual Fuel Tax
